Milk Test Permit Application Order Form

Please check one of the following Milk Test options below.

Send this order form and the appropriate fees to the address below.

Please read the entire rules and requirements for each test, these are only summaries of each test. All does must meet NDGA height standards to participate in any milk test.

____ Option A Standard 20 or DHI Conventional 305 DAY TEST* with DHI TESTER every Month AM/PM milk sampling

____ Option E. (Code 00) Every Other Month (EOM) DHI Tester weighs, records, samples AM/PM milk samples every other month. Owner weighs, records samples AM/PM milk for the Intervening months and sends to lab with barn sheets.

____ Option F. (Code 40) Owner Sampler (OS) Owner weighs milk, samples and sends samples in monthly. Height must be recorded at the beginning and end of lactation. Owner will send in height certificate to Milk Chair. To be eligible for Top Ten there must be two verification tests.

____ 305 DAY GROUP TEST* Must be a Group of 3 or more breeders. All members must choose the same option for testing and one as a supervisor who weighs and samples each herd (not their own) and is responsible for sending in samples and barn sheets. The other members alternate testing the supervisors herd. If any of the group drops out the test may become unofficial.

____ One Day Milk Test **Group** test at a show \$25 (30 days or more prior to show) National Show is not required to pay fees for Milk Test.

____ One Day Milk Test **Individual** at home \$6 Plus \$1 per goat tested.

* Note: DHI fees may vary from state to state. It is your responsibility to make all arrangements for a DHI tester to come and test your herd.
