Come join us for a weekend of fun and togetherness with old friends, meet new ones and have the opportunity to show and promote the Nigerian Goats.

**WHAT: 2 SANCTIONED NDGA SHOWS...2 SANCTIONED AGS SHOWS**  
**WHEN: SATURDAY and SUNDAY OCTOBER 9 & 10, 2010**  
**WHERE: PAHRUMP, NEVADA (70 Miles West of Las Vegas)**  
**JUDGES: SANDI LISKA AND DOTTY CLARK - NDGA**  
**RUSTY REPP AND DENISE HASTY - AGS**

**Saturday will be NDGA, double judge format. Sunday will be the 2 AGS Shows.**

**We will have our Pahrump Classic Costume Contest on Saturday after the NDGA shows. All Goats and Handlers entered must be in costume! Our Judges will be awarding Prizes for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place. This should be a fun event so start thinking of a costume now...don't be shy....adults can enter with their goats too!**

**Directions:** West from Las Vegas. Take Route 160 into Pahrump. Directly after the Second stoplight (Basin Road/Albertsons Shopping Center) on the Left hand side of the highway is Petrack Park and Community Center. Turn Left into the front of the Park.

South from CA. Take Interstate 15 North and turn at the Baker, CA exit Route 127 into Shoshone, CA and turn Right on Route 178 into Pahrump. Turn Left at the First Stoplight. Directly after the next stoplight (Basin Road/Albertsons Shopping Center) on the Left hand side of the highway is Petrack Park and Community Center. Turn Left into the front of the Park.

North from Reno area. Take Route 95 South. Just before Mercury and the Test site will be a sign for Route 160 and Pahrump. Turn Right. Take Route 160 into Pahrump and the Park will be on the Right hand side of the road at the First stoplight Basin Road/Albertsons Shopping Center. **PLEASE OBSERVE THE SPEED LIMITS IN PAHRUMP.**

**Entry Fees** \$6.00 per goat per class for each Show. No late fees will be applied, however I would appreciate everyone returning their Entry Forms by OCTOBER 1, 2010. **No Entry Fee for Showmanship Classes.**

**Show Times** We will have Showmanship Classes on Saturday **only**, at 8am. The first NDGA Shows will begin immediately afterward. The Sunday Show will start at 9am

**Check In** You will be able to check in anytime after 12 Noon on Friday October 8, 2008. No health certificates are required at this show, however please use common sense and do not bring animals that show signs of any contagious disease

**Pens** \$5.00 per pen (this is for the entire weekend). Pens are good size and will accommodate several animals so you won't need as many. Pens will be on a **First come First serve basis** and if you can double up on your goats that will help us provide pens for everyone. If you have portable pens please bring them. No bedding will be necessary as the grounds are on grass. Please clean your pen area and remove left over hay from the grounds before you leave.

**Overnight** This is a public park. You are welcome to pitch a tent, sleep in your truck, or park your motor home, however there are no dump stations or shower facilities available. **NEW! If you are sleeping in the park Friday night through Sunday night, please let me know, as new park rules dictate handing out parking passes to insert in the window of your vehicle. There is no cost for this.**

**Motels** There is some event happening in the area the same weekend that we were not aware of ...**PLEASE MAKE YOUR HOTEL RESERVATION ASAP!** If you have problems securing a room and do not want to camp at the park, please let me know.
